The warning period and start of Pima County's speed enforcement program is being extended. The first four cameras had been expected to start issuing citations today.

The vendor for the program, American Traffic Solutions (ATS), requested the delay to allow the company to complete additional quality assurance testing and physically review each of the installed sites. Initial speed verification testing by ATS of some individual lane locations did not meet the company's strict quality assurance requirements prompting the request. ATS will not bring the program online until all quality assurance testing is confirmed and verified by Pima County.

The four locations that were to begin issuing citations today were:

- North La Cholla Boulevard near West Sunset Road
- South Mission Road near West Grubstake Drive
- East Ina Road near North Camino de las Candelas
- North Swan Road near East Calle Barril

The other six speed-enforcement cameras Pima County has installed will begin their warning periods on May 1st.
