## **Traffic Stop Leads to Narcotics Seizure, Arrests**

**January 30, 2020**

On Wednesday, January 29, 2020, at approximately 11:00 a.m., Deputies conducted a traffic stop on a passenger vehicle on Ajo Hwy. and South Camino De Oeste. During the investigation, a K-9 alerted to the presence of narcotics. A search of the vehicle revealed approximately 87,000 "M-30" (counterfeit oxycodone) pills weighing about 21 lbs. and approximately 13 pounds of cocaine concealed in the vehicle. The approximate street value of the pills seized was \$435,000. The approximate street value of the cocaine seized was approximately \$150,000.

The investigation led to the arrest of 45-year old Veronica Jacquez and 23-year-old Odalis Leyva for Possession of a Narcotic Drug for Sale and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, which are both felony charges.
