Robbery of a Fast Food Restaurant, Suspect Apprehended

August 10, 2020

On Saturday August 8, 2020, at about 7:00 a.m., Deputies responded to the McDonalds at 5225 South Palo Verde Rd. for a report of a robbery. According to witnesses, a suspect entered the restaurant and demanded money, threatening employees with a bladed tool or weapon. The suspect fled the store without obtaining any money and none of the employees were injured.

Deputies responding to the area located a man that matched the suspect's description, who attempted to run away. The man was taken into custody and was subsequently charged with Armed Robbery and three counts of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon.

The suspect has been identified as 23-year-old Abraham Kosterlitzky.

Detectives from the Violent Crimes Section have taken over this investigation, which is ongoing.
