Vehicle Break-In at Rillito River Park

February 18, 2020

On Friday, November 29, 2019, at about 2:30 p.m., Deputies responded to the Rillito River Park access off of River Fringe Dr. for a report of a vehicle break-in. Upon arrival, they discovered that a vehicle had a passenger window broken out and a purse had been taken. Within minutes, the victim's credit cards were used at the Family Dollar at 1354 West Prince Rd. to buy several hundred dollars' worth of gift cards.

The male suspect is described as:

- Hispanic, in his 20s or 30's, with a beard and glasses
- Average height and build
- Last seen wearing a white "Levi" sweatshirt

Auto Theft detectives have taken over the investigation and are asking for the public's assistance in identifying the suspect from this case. Anyone with information is asked to call 9-1-1. You can also submit an anonymous tip, with the potential for a reward, by text, phone, or by going to 88-CRIME.org.
