Item 2 on the agenda was the Pledge of Allegiance.


Item 3 on the agenda was the approval of minutes from the meeting held on 09/03/25. Mr. Duffner moved to approve the minutes as submitted. Sgt. Goritz seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Item 4 on the agenda was the review of DROP extension for Christopher Hogan. Ms. Jobst explained that the Mr. Hogan would have existed DROP in 01/2026 and was approved to extend to 01/2028.

Item 5 on the agenda was the review, discussion, and possible action regarding the new Accidental Disability Retirement Application for Augustine Gonzalez.
