This narrative documents a sobriety checkpoint deployment conducted by the Pima County Sheriff's Department on Wednesday, July 4, 2012 on Aviation Parkway at Richey Boulevard under the Veterans Memorial overpass. As the DUI Unit Supervisor I planned the operation and conducted the informational briefing for personnel participating in the deployment.

The briefing took place at 1300 hours at the Sheriff's Department Administration Building, in the Operations Center and was delivered via PowerPoint.

Once all participating personnel were given their assignments and completed, signed and turned in their sobriety checkpoint briefing checklist, they travelled to the checkpoint location.

The checkpoint became operational at approximately 1408 hours and lasted until 1730 hours. During this time, there were 1,755 vehicles that passed through the sobriety checkpoint. There were no field sobriety tests (FST) conducted, resulting in no Driving Under the Influence (DUI) arrests.

This operation was originally scheduled to take place on Mount Lemmon Highway. Weather forecasts broadcast on July 3rd called for widespread monsoon thunderstorms on July 4th, as a result of those forecasts I changed the checkpoint location prior to finalizing the operation plan. It did rain as forecasted.
